



## Swimming Pool Admission Policy Scenarios

1 Adult	1 x Under 3yrs	Yes	
1 Adult	More than 1 x Under 3yrs	No	Policy is 0-3yrs olds must be supervised on a 1:1 ratio
1 Adult	1 x Under 3 & 1 x 4-8yrs	No	Policy is under 3yrs olds must be supervised on 1:1 ratio as this will leave the 4-8 year old unsupervised
1 Adult	1 x 4-8yrs	Yes	
1 Adult	2 x 4-8yrs	Yes	
1 Adult	3 x 4-8yrs	Yes but	Only if one or more has completed competency assessment OR all swimmers wear buoyancy aids and swim within designated non-swimming area (i.e. they remain in shallow water)
1 Adult	4 x 4-8yrs	No	Policy is 4-8yr olds ratio must be no more than 3:1
2 Adults	2 x Under 3yrs	Yes	
2 Adults	Any more than 2 x Under 3yrs	No	Policy is ratio must be 1:1 as this will leave additional children unsupervised
2 Adults	1 x Under 3yrs and 1 x 4-8yrs	Yes	
2 Adults	1 x Under 3yrs and 2 x 4-8yrs	Yes	
2 Adults	1 x Under 3yrs and 3 x 4-8yrs	Yes but	Only if one or more has completed competency assessment OR weak swimmers wear buoyancy aids and swim within designated non-swimming area (i.e. they remain in shallow water)
2 Adults	Up to 4 x 4-8yrs	Yes	
2 Adults	5 x 4-8yrs	Yes but	Only if one or more has completed competency assessment OR weak swimmers wear buoyancy aids and swim within designated non-swimming area (i.e. they remain in shallow water)
2 Adults	6 x 4-8yrs	Yes but	Only if two or more has completed competency assessment OR weak swimmers wear buoyancy aids and swim within designated non-swimming area (i.e. they remain in shallow water)
2 Adults	7 x 4-8yrs	No	Policy is 4-8yrs ratio must be no more than 3:1

Children who are competent swimmers aged between 9-10 years old may swim unaccompanied but must have a responsible person (16+) supervising them (inside the building)

Children who are 11 years old (in year 7) and above may swim unaccompanied and unsupervised



# HAILEYBURY SPORTS COMPLEX

## Swimming competency assessment test:

- Jump or dive into deep water unaided and swim 50m using a recognised stroke (backstroke, breast stroke, butterfly, front crawl). The time allowance for this will be 3mins.
- Tread water for 30 seconds.
- Complete a head first surface dive and retrieve a submersible aid from a pool depth of 2.0m
- Climb out unaided without the use of steps.
