

Haileybury Parents/Pupils use of Sports Complex

Dear Parent/Pupil,

I'd like to take this opportunity to clarify our policy on parent/pupil usage of facilities at the sports complex. During holiday periods, when the College is effectively closed, all usage of sports complex facilities is chargeable. For example if you wanted to hire a badminton court or a squash court or indeed you wished to swim you would be asked to pay in line with our current pricing.

During term time hire of activity areas (squash courts, sports hall and the all weather surface) is again chargeable but only when pre-booked. If however parents/pupils wished to play during College hours and courts are available then they can do so without having to pay.

The use of the fitness suite for pupils is, for reasons of safety, governed by a number of pre-requisites (e.g. students have to have undertaken an induction and filled out a health screening questionnaire and have to be over 16 years old). Only having met these requirements may current pupils then obtain access to the gym however this arrangement is beset with restrictions set by house masters and is only available during term time (school hours). For everyone else the gym is a chargeable activity.

The use of the swimming pool is chargeable all year round.
